The fruits are also slightly ribbed, dark and glossy with a short neck and around 34-40cm long with good shelf life. The plant produces an abundance of fruit, around 50-100 per plant.

Scoville Heat Scale - Rating Process

The effective heat of chilli peppers is measured in scoville heat units (shu). This is defined as the number of times a chilli extract needs to be diluted in water for it to lose its heat. At the lowest end of the scale are bell pepper ranking at 0 shu. Jalapenos rate between 3 to 6,000 shu and Habanero top 300,000 shu.

POISONOUS PLANTS

In our catalogues, we list some varieties which are included in the Horticultural Trades Association's listing of potentially harmful plants. Some seed can be harmful if swallowed, and may produce a plant which is poisonous or has an irritant sap. With such items, particular care is taken. If any problems do occur, medical attention should be sought immediately. The following items come into this category and should be labelled as recommended in the 2000 review of the 'HTA Code of Practice Relating to the Labelling of Potentially Harmful Plants' when offered for sale to the public.

Acalypha

Skin and eye irritant/harmful if eaten.

Aconitum

CAUTION: Toxic if eaten/harmful via skin.

Alstroemeria

May cause skin allergy.

Asparagus

May cause skin allergy/fruits harmful if eaten.

Calla Lily (Zantedeschia)

Poisonous, skin and eye irritant.

Capsicum annum Skin and eve irritar

Skin and eye irritant/harmful if eaten.

Chrysanthemum

CAUTION: May cause skin allergy.

Colocasia Esculenta

Harmful if eaten/skin and eye irritant.

Delphinium

Harmful if eaten.

Digitalis

CAUTION: Toxic if eaten.
